Basil Fino Verde	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun		Dwarf globe-shaped bush with small leaves
Basil, Aroma	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	20-24"	Fusarium wilt resistant
Basil, Cinnamon	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun		Purple stems, beautiful garden plant with many culinary uses
Basil, dolumnar	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	18-24"	Small leaves, good strong flavor, may be grown indoors in winter
Basil, Dwarf	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun		Bushy, upright plant with small leaves
Basil, Genovese	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun		The original pesto basil
Basil, Holy (Sacred)	<i>O. basilicum sanctum</i>	A	Sun	18-24"	Clove scent, used in cold dishes only as well as in ceremony
Basil, Lemon	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	16-20"	Use the chopped leaves on fish from the grill
Basil, Lime	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	16-20"	Makes a refreshing tea, interesting addition to salads
Basil, Mammoth	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	24"	Large leaves often used for wrapping small appetizers
Basil, Red Rubin	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	16-20"	Slightly stronger than the green basil, beautiful in the garden
Basil, Sweet	<i>O. basilicum</i>	A	Sun	16-20"	A variety of Genovese basil with comparable flavor
Basil, Thai	<i>O. basilicum 'Siam Queen'</i>	A	Sun	12-18"	More assertive taste than most, small leaves on purple stems
Brown-eyed Susan	<i>Rudbeckia hirta 'Prairie Sun'</i>	A	Sun	20-26"	Flowers have green centers, yellow petals with white tips
Calendula	<i>Calendula officinalis</i>	A	Sun	2'3'	Orange flowers, continuous bloom if deadheaded, good medicinal
Catnip	<i>Nepeta cataria</i>	P	Sun	1-2'	Surround with chicken wire until well established
Chamomile, German	<i>Matricaria recutita</i>	A	Sun	2'	Tiny daisy-like blossoms fresh or dried make marvelous tea
Chervil	<i>Anthriscus cerefolium</i>	A	Shade, cool	12-18"	Provide consistent moisture, likes cool soil
Chives	<i>Allium schoenoprasum</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	12"	Delicate onion flavor. Use pieces of the blossoms in salads
Chives, garlic	<i>Allium tuberosum</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	12-18"	Delicate garlic/onion flavor in both blossoms and leaves
Cleome	<i>Cleome hasslerana</i>	A	Sun	5'	Hummingbird favorite, blooms all summer
Coleus, Black Dragon	<i>Solenostemon scutellaroides</i>	A	Sun/Pt Shade	12-18"	Red to purple shading with rippled edges
Coleus, Sonatina Gold	<i>Solenostemon scutellaroides</i>	A	Sun/Pt Shade	10-16"	Chartreuse color pairs beautifully with others
Comfrey, true	<i>Symphytum officinalis</i>	P	Sun	3'	Traditionally used for external wound healing, vigorous grower
Dill, Bouquet	<i>Anethum graveolens</i>	A	Sun	2-3'	Bushy, available in Cow Pots for easy transplanting
Dill, Fernleaf	<i>Anethum graveolens</i>	A	Sun	18-24"	Good leaf production, available in Cow Pots for easy transplanting
Elecampane	<i>Inula helenium</i>	P	Sun	6'	Dramatic in the landscape, harvest roots for medicinal use
Fennel, Bronze	<i>Foeniculum vulgare dulce</i>	P	Sun	4'	Distinctive, dramatic, also host for black swallowtail caterpillar
Feverfew	<i>Tanacetum parthenium</i>	P	Sun	18-24"	Small daisy-like flowers, vigorous grower, abundant reseeder
Fountain Grass	<i>Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian'</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	3'	Turns golden w/red-orange tints in fall. Well-drained soil
Fountain Grass	<i>Pennisetum setaceum 'Rubrum'</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	3'	Bronze leaf blades, purplish-pink feathery seed heads
Fuschia 'Gartenmeister'	<i>Fuschia triphylla</i>	TP	Sun	24"	Upright with drooping clusters of red flowers, bring in for winter
Geranium, Rose	<i>Pelargonium x asperum</i>	A	Sun	18-24"	Fragrant leaves, sparse pink fragrant flowers, bring in for winter
Gotu Kola	<i>Centella asiatica</i>	A	Light Shade	8-10"	Tropical medicinal, attractive in hangers as foliage plant
Ladys Mantle	<i>Alchemilla mollis</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	12-24"	Scalloped leaves collect the dew, sprays of yellow flowers dry well
Lambs Ear	<i>Stachys byzantina</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	6-8"	Soft downy leaves used historically as bandages

Lavender 'Munstead'	<i>Lavandula angustifolia</i>	P	Sun	18"	Early blooming English lavender. Good drainage for all lavenders
Lavender, 'Hidcote Blue'	<i>Lavandula angustifolia</i>	P	Sun	1'	Deeper blue than Munstead, compact plants
Lavender, 'Vincenza Blue'	<i>Lavandula angustifolia</i>	P	Sun	1'	More compact with powerful, less sweet aroma
Lemon Balm	<i>Melissa officinalis</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	1-2'	Fresh leaves make a delightful tea, tiny flowers attract bees
Lemon Verbena	<i>Aloysia triphylla</i>	TP	Sun	2-3'	Strong, delightful lemon scented leaves for tea and cooking
Lemongrass	<i>Cymbopogon citratus</i>	TP	Sun/Pt Shade	3-4'	Aromatic leaves used in tea and flavoring
Lion's Tail (Wilde Dagga)	<i>Leonitus leonurus</i>	TP	Sun	3'	Shrubby pot plant. Orange flwrs in late summer, early fall
Lobelia, Great Blue	<i>Lobelia syphilitica</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	2'	Fall bloomer, prolific reseeder
Lovage	<i>Levisticum officinale</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	3-4'	Celery flavored leaves for salads, soups & sauces
Marjoram, Sweet	<i>Origanum majorana</i>	A	Sun	18"	A sweeter version of oregano for use in salads, stews, meat dishes
Milk Thistle	<i>Silybum marianum</i>	A	Sun	3'	Stunning green & white leaves with purple thistle blossom, medicinal
Millet, Foxtail	<i>Setaria italica</i>	A	Sun	3'	Large pendulous bronze seedheads good for dried arrangements
Mint, Mojito	<i>Mentha x villosa</i>	P	Sun	24"	Essential ingredient in Cuban Mojito cocktail. Warm mild mint flavor
Mint, Mountain	<i>Pycnanthemum flexuosum</i>	P	Sun	2-3'	Vase shaped clumps are beautiful when dried
Mint, Peppermint (True Black)	<i>Mentha piperita</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	24-30"	Strong flavor, tea is delicious and good for digestion
Mint, Spearmint	<i>Mentha spicata</i>	P	Sun	18-24"	A lighter more delicate mint
Nasturtium, Jewel	<i>Tropaeolum spp</i>	A	Sun	15"	Bushy plants, blooms above foliage, peppery-tasting flowers, leaves
Nicotiana 'Only the Lonely'	<i>N. sylvestris</i>	A	Sun/Pt Shade	5'	Fragrant drooping clusters of white blossoms.
Oregano, Golden Creeping	<i>Origanum vulgare aureum</i>	P	Sun	6-12"	Mild oregano flavor, leaves vary from golden to light green
Oregano, Greek	<i>Origanum vulgare hirtum</i>	P	Sun	6-12"	Intense oregano flavor, grows best in light soil
Papalo, Round Leaf	<i>Porophyllum ruderale</i>	A	Sun/Pt Shade	3'	Superb cilantro substitute lasting all summer. Use youngest leaves
Parsley, Curly	<i>Petroselinium crispum</i>	B	Sun	12-15"	A lovely garnish and a great digestive
Parsley, Flat Leaf	<i>Petroselinium crispum</i>	B	Sun	12-15"	Preferred for cooking, high in protein, vitamins A & C
Pennyroyal	<i>Mentha pulegium</i>	P	Sun	6-10"	Strong smelling leaves often used as insect repellent. Sprawling
Pleurisy Root (Butterfly Weed)	<i>Asclepias tuberosa</i>	P	Sun	2'	Late blooming butterfly attractor
Purple Coneflower	<i>Echinacea purpurea</i>	P	Sun/Pt Shade	24-36"	Attracts all beneficials, medicinal, lovely cut flower
Rosemary 'Arp'	<i>Rosemarinus officinalis</i>	TP	Sun/Pt Shade	2-3'	Scented needle-like foliage excellent for cooking
Sage, Berggarten	<i>Salvia officinalis</i>	P	Sun	18-24"	Lovely garden plant, strong scented large leaves for cooking
Sage, Pineapple	<i>Salvia elegans</i>	A	Sun	3'	Atomatic foliage, stunning red blooms late summer, early fall
Sage, Variegated	<i>Salvia 'Icterina'</i>	P	Sun	24"	Gold/green leaves with mildly warm spicy flavored leaves
Salad Bowls	<i>Various greens</i>	A	Sun	6-10"	Variety of greens may be cut for salads. Fertilize lightly every 3 wks
Savory Summer	<i>Satureja hortensis</i>	A	Sun	1.5'	Plant near beans to repel Mexican Bean Beetle
Sneezeweed	<i>Helenium autumnale</i>	P	Sun	4-5'	Cut back twice during summer, late summer blooms
Stevia	<i>Stevia rebaudiana</i>	A	Sun	2-3'	Leaves used as sugar substitute. Cut back to promote bushy growth
Sweet Annie	<i>Artemisia annua</i>	A	Sun	4-6'	Fragrant apple-scented foliage cut in September for dried decoration
Sweet Woodruff	<i>Galium odoratum</i>	P	Shade	8"	Spreading ground cover with early season white starry blooms
Tarragon, French	<i>Artemisia dracunculus</i>	P	Sun	2'	Subtle fine anise flavor for salads, soups, sauces, vinegar
Thyme, Creeping	<i>Thymus serpyllum</i>	P	Sun	6"	Excellent groundcover, needs good drainage
Thyme, French	<i>Thymus vulgaris</i>	P	Sun	18"	Cut back twice during summer to prevent fungus
Thyme, German	<i>Thymus vulgaris</i>	P	Sun	10-12"	Prefers slightly alkaline soil, cut back after blooming

Thyme, Magic Carpet	<i>Thymus serpyllum</i>	P	Sun	8"	Mat-forming ground cover
